## WARM WELCOME 2026!





### Important Reminder: Signing In and Out of Children

Please be reminded that each family member who signs a child in and out must use their **own** mobile number and code. It is important that you do not use another individual's mobile number, as you are legally responsible for signing the child in and out. This information is recorded in our system and is crucial for the Child Care Subsidy (CCS) process.

Additionally, we've noticed that the iPad stand has been bent due to children pushing on it. A reminder sign has been placed to encourage families not to allow children to touch the iPads. These devices are used for accurately signing in your child, and allowing children to touch the buttons can affect the proper logging of your child's attendance.

## FEES

When making a payment toward your child's fees, please remember to include your **child's name** as the payment reference. This helps us easily identify who the payment is for.



## DOOR SAFETY

For the safety of the children, staff, and families, it is of great importance that the door **is closed and shut behind you** when entering and exiting through the front door.

If you see unfamiliar faces at the door, please kindly ask them to wait outside the door and you will get a staff member to attend to them.

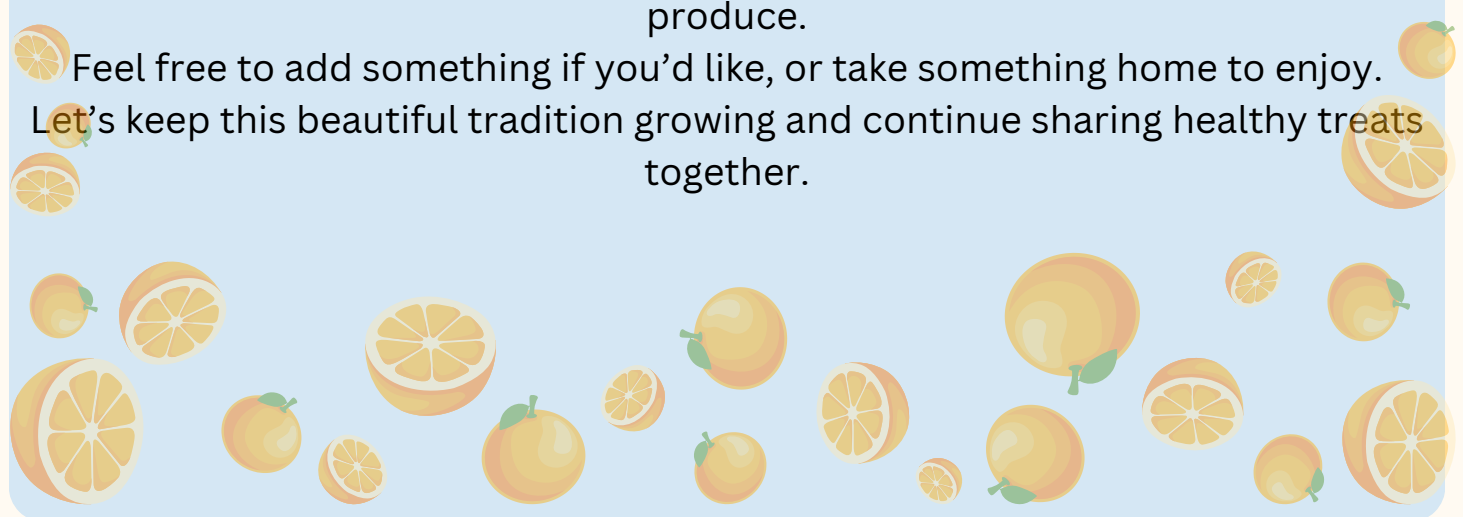


## FRUIT BASKET
